

The UMMC Family Scholarship for Graduate/Professional Programs

Scholarship Guidelines

- I. Student Eligibility
 - Must be enrolled in a graduate or professional program at UMMC and not eligible for the staff and dependent tuition waiver program (Faculty/Staff Scholarship).
 - Parent or step-parent must be a current full time UMMC employee, deceased while a full time UMMC employee or retired UMMC employee under PERS guidelines.
 - Parent or step-parent must have worked full time 12 consecutive months at the time the application is submitted to Financial Aid.

- II. Funding
 - One award annually regardless of the number of parents/step parents employed at UMMC.
 - Must apply for scholarship annually.
 - The amount of scholarship award will be determined annually based upon the availability of funds (Award amount may vary).
 - The amount of UMMC Family Scholarship plus all other tuition/fee scholarships will not exceed UMMC tuition and fee charges.
 - Scholarship may be awarded for each year student is enrolled and eligible.

- III. Verification Documentation. Documents must be submitted with application.
 - For children of the employee – certified copy of birth certificate.
 - For step-children of the employee – certified copy of birth certificate and certified copy of parental marriage license.
 - For children whose legal guardian is an employee – certified copy of court order.
 - For children/step-children/legal guardian of deceased employee – certified copy of birth certificate, certified copy of parental marriage license, certified copy of court order, and certified copy of death certificate.
 - For children/step-children/legal guardian of retired employee – official notification of PERS benefits, certified copy of birth certificate and certified copy of parental marriage license, and certified copy of court order.

 - Application Deadline – must be submitted before last day to withdraw from a course. You will only receive funding for the current and remaining terms in the academic year if you are enrolled.

*Birth certificate must list both parents.
